## Local residents aim for a cleaner High Barnet by launching the High Barnet Car Club

The High Barnet Green Home Zone has launched a drive to introduce a Car Club in High Barnet. They say that findings from other Car Club schemes will see a reduction in traffic and pollution, and make the streets of High Barnet safer for pedestrians, especially children. They need 150 residents to sign up to pay just £59.50 a year to get the Car Club introduced.

Local resident Leon Pein, who along with Tanya Adams is co-ordinating the initiative for the High Barnet Green Home Zone, says of the scheme, which has already been successful in other areas of North London: "Joining a Car Club could lead to a big reduction in traffic, less exhaust pollution and lower CO2 emissions in High Barnet, whilst saving members a great deal of money."

Residents who join the Car Club are able to pre-book a car and enjoy all the benefits without the expense - no MOT, repairs and car insurance. It's a car when you need it, not when you don't. Those who drive less than 6,000 miles a year, could save £3,500 annually, according to Car Plus, an independent Government body. Replacing a second family car could save even more as the cost of using the cars is as little as £4.95 an hour with 30 miles free fuel per day.

Local residents can earn money by contributing a parking space to the High Barnet Car Club. If you want to find out more and sign up to join the Car Club, you can meet members of the not-for-profit group at the Foulds School event on 12 June, 10-1pm; the Friends of Barnet Countryside Centre fair on 13 June, 2-5pm; and in The Spires on 26 June, 10-4pm.
